Author and Historian




Steve Puleo returns to the REBA Conference podium, after a well-received luncheon keynote address at the Association's 2022 Spring Conference. A former award-winning journalist, prolific author, historian and educator, Steve will speak about his most recent book, *The Great Abolitionist: Charles Sumner and the Fight for a More Perfect Union*. He has also authored seven other books, all of which have been Boston regional bestsellers and received national recognition. His work has been reviewed favorably by the *Wall Street Journal*, the *New Yorker*, the *Boston Globe*, and the *New York Post*, amongst others.

Puleo is a contributor of feature stories and book reviews to *American History* magazine and the *Boston Globe*. He has taught history at Suffolk University and UMass-Boston. His books have been woven into the curricula of numerous high schools and colleges, and more than 30 communities have selected his books as "community-wide reads." His books include:

- The Great Abolitionist: Charles Sumner and the Fight for a More Perfect Union
- Voyage of Mercy: The USS Jamestown, the Irish Famine, and the Remarkable Story of America's First Humanitarian Mission
- American Treasures: The Secret Efforts to Save the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution, and the Gettysburg Address
- The Caning: The Assault That Drove America to Civil War
- A City So Grand: The Rise of an American Metropolis, Boston 1850-1900
- The Boston Italians: A Story of Pride, Perseverance and Paesani, from the Years of the Great Immigration to the Present Day
- Due to Enemy Action: The True World War II Story of the USS Eagle 56
- Dark Tide: The Great Boston Molasses Flood of 1919

Steve holds a master's in history from UMass-Boston. Steve and his wife Kate, who live south of Boston, donate a portion of book proceeds to benefit juvenile diabetes research.

The Great Abolitionist: Charles Sumner and the Fight for a More Perfect Union, the first major biography of Charles Sumner to be published in over 50 years, relates the story of one of the most influential political figures in American history with evocative and accessible prose, transporting readers back to an era when our leaders exhibited true courage and authenticity in the face of unprecedented challenges.
