Ben Robbins is the Senior Staff Attorney at the New England Legal Foundation (NELF), a non-profit public interest law firm that advocates on behalf of businesses, employers, and property owners, by filing amicus curiae briefs in the state and federal appellate courts of New England, and in the United States Supreme Court. NELF's mission is to promote inclusive economic growth in New England, protect the free enterprise system, and defend economic rights.

Ben has written and filed appellate briefs for NELF on a wide range of legal topics, including the Federal Arbitration Act, the Fair Labor Standards Act, the Massachusetts Wage Act, the First Amendment, issues of personal jurisdiction under the Due Process Clause, and the limits to the Commonwealth's powers of eminent domain. Ben has written articles for the legal and popular press, such as the *Boston Business Journal* and *Massachusetts Lawyers Weekly*. He has also developed a warm rapport with the reporters of the latter publication, who frequently interview Ben and quote him in articles covering Massachusetts cases in which he has filed an amicus brief for NELF.

After graduating from law school, Ben was a judicial law clerk for (then) Associate Justice Herbert P. Wilkins of the Massachusetts. Ben then worked for several years as an Assistant Attorney General for the Commonwealth, in the Administrative Law Division of the Government Bureau. Ben subsequently worked in private practice at a litigation boutique, before joining NELF as a staff attorney.

Ben received his J.D. from the University of Pennsylvania Law School.
